## 2022-2023 STOUGHTON SCHOOL DISTRICT DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAM

CESA #2 is assisting Stoughton High School with the Drivers' Education Program. For your convenience, students may attain a Wisconsin driver's license through a program offered by CESA #2, at the Stoughton High Schools' campus, both during the school year and during the summer. Both the classroom classes and Behind the Wheel lessons are taught at Stoughton High School. CESA #2 follows all policies and procedures that are set by the Stoughton High School.

Driver Education is a foundation course, which teaches the theory of responsible driving, defensive driving, and emphasis is placed on the introduction of the proper safety mechanics of safe driving. The course is designed to improve the student's knowledge of traffic safety and to become safe operators of motor vehicles. The course covers all areas of vehicle operation, legal obligations, maintenance, effects of alcohol and other drugs, with a strong emphasis on distracted driving.

#### **PROGRAM COST**

**Traditional Classroom \$165.00**- Driver Education is a foundation course which teaches the theory of responsible driving. Emphasis is placed upon introduction of mechanics of driving, execution of most driving operations, and a thorough understanding of rules of safe driving. We provide 30 hours of classroom instruction.

Students that attend the class without registering with CESA 2 will be dismissed from class and not receive instruction. Please indicate below if your student has any special education needs. We will do our best to accommodate them.

CESA 2 requires information on any special needs that your child might have i.e. hearing impaired, ADD, IEP's, juvenile diabetes, etc. We will do our best to accommodate the needs for your child's success.

**Online Class Course \$175.00**- The Online Driver Education course offered by CESA 2 provides a unique opportunity for students that have busy schedules to learn critical skills needed to become a safe, low-risk driver. Our program is one of few that meet the National and State Standards for online learning. Your child will have an instructor to work with them throughout the course.

Online Course Required Textbook: This course is based on the AAA's book, <u>How to Drive</u>. **This book must be purchased** and is not provided through CESA 2. <u>How to Drive</u> is offered as a soft-cover book or an e-book. For more information regarding CESA 2 online course and links to purchase the required textbook, please access our website <u>at http://cesa2.com</u>. To ensure you are purchasing the correct textbook, please do not order until you receive the email containing the link to order it.

There is a \$50.00 fee for all online extensions.

**Behind the Wheel** - Unfortunately at this time we are not accepting new behind-the-wheel registrations due to pandemic impact and staffing. During this time we are focusing on the students we already have registered for BTW in this district. Our classroom and online course is recognized and accepted by the DMV and DPI as approved Driver Education courses which can transfer to commercial schools for BTW instruction.

**Refunds:** No refunds or transfer of registration fees between students will be issued after one year from the date of the original registration. There is a \$50.00 processing fee for all refunds during the one-year period. All service fees for credit card transactions are non-refundable.

If your student has completed any portion of the online course, we will also withhold a portion of the registration fee for payment to the online instructor's time spent working with your student. The cost for the textbook is non-refundable.
